


Configure GoodData for Single Sign-On

Configuring GoodData for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix Gateway service. Users can securely log on to GoodData by using the enterprise credentials.

To configure GoodData for SSO by using SAML:

1. In a browser, type <https://secure.gooddata.com/account.html?> and press **Enter**.
2. Enter your GoodData admin credentials (**E-mail** and **Password**) and click **Sign in**.

3. To enable and configure SSO, the user must contact the GoodData support team and provide them with the following details:

Required Information	Description
Redirect Login URL	IdP logon URL
External Key (Identity Provider Issuer)	Issuer ID
